Rosh Hashanah Second Day

Tuesday September 11th

Meet at Oak Flats Picnic Area: From Albuquerque, Drive east on I-40 to Exit 175 toward Tijeras, NM. Drive South for 9 miles on State Road 337 (aka James McGrane Memorial Highway). Look for the brown "Oak Flat- Cibola National Forest" Sign, on the East side of the road. Turn east onto Oak Flat Road and follow it for .39 miles until you reach the entrance on the left side of the road. Follow the directional signs at the entrance to your site. Don't forget to bring chairs, blankets, umbrellas, and hats. If you wish, bring a picnic lunch, and plan to stay awhile to enjoy this special place.

Adults with children in childcare are asked to sit in a designated area in the Sanctuary. (a maximum of 6 seats per family.)

Seating

Ushers will fill the sanctuary from front to back. Sanctuary doors will be closed at the start of services. We ask at that time you use the rear entry to the Sanctuary. In order to facilitate seating for everyone, we ask that you do not save seats in the sanctuary except for ushers, persons with disabilities, and those who are participating in the service on the bimah.

Security

Security policies are in place for the safety of all attending services. As always, your cooperation is greatly appreciated. All members and guests attending High Holy Day services should be prepared to present their ticket. Please be advised that personal items brought to any of the worship venues will be subject to examination by the security personnel.

Parking

There is no parking in the area directly at the front entrance; it will be for drop-off and valet only. All available handicap parking spaces will be marked. Valet parking will be available to those who are handicapped or otherwise need special assistance. Please arrive 15 minutes prior to service for valet parking. Please park in the designated spaces in the lots to the north and west of the building. Overflow parking is available on our undeveloped land to the south of the building- enter on Stardust. Do not park in the lot to the north of the building that serves other businesses. Do not leave valuables in your car.

Challah

Orders forms for 1 ½ lb round challah are available at the office. For more information please visit the office or call 505-883-1818. Deadline for Rosh Hashanah orders is September 15th. Deadline for Yom Kippur orders is September 27th.

A Special Message from The Clergy

Fasting on Yom Kippur is forbidden if it presents risks to your health. Please check with your doctor as to whether fasting is advisable. Also, some medications cannot be taken on an empty stomach—be careful at the end of the day. The clergy will be happy to discuss this with you if you have questions. Contact the office for the appropriate prayer if you are not fasting.

Reciprocity Tickets

Through the URJ, individuals who belong to a Reform synagogue can attend High Holy Day services at other Reform temples around the world. If you plan to be away for the High Holy Days let us know well in advance, so we can send the appropriate paperwork to the synagogue you would like to attend.
