CONGREGATION ALBERT CAMP/YOUTH SCHOLARSHIPS

Educating and nurturing our children are important commitments of our congregation, whether they're attending Religious School, Hebrew School, Israel programs, youth group programs, or Jewish camps. We recognize that there may be occasions in our congregants' lives when they have temporary financial hardships. It is our goal to award scholarships in such situations to help cover camp tuition when funds are available.

In deciding to award a scholarship, the Scholarship Committee must consider the needs of each applicant, the total number of requests, and the monies available for camp scholarships. For the majority of cases, only a partial scholarship can be given. In order for your child to receive a scholarship, you must be a member in good standing. If your child receives a scholarship, Congregation Albert asks that you would reciprocate by donating your time to the congregation in whatever capacity you deem appropriate; for example, serving on a committee, volunteering in the classroom or office or at camp, etc. You may contact the office to learn about more opportunities to serve in the congregation.

In order to assist the Congregation Albert Scholarship Committee in evaluating your request, please complete this form and return it to the bookkeeper. The bookkeeper will verify membership and forward application on to Director of Jewish Education. The Director will verify additional eligibility criteria and forward to the Scholarship Committee. All applications are confidential and will be reviewed by the Committee on a case-by-case basis. You can expect that the Scholarship Committee will make its decisions in a timely fashion and will notify you of the results.

Applications will be submitted on the following schedule:

May 31 URJ Camps, Camp Oranim, NFTY March/April

Last Friday in July Fall Semester EIE, NFTY August/September Events

July 31 NFTY October Events

October 31 L'Taken, NFTY January/February, Spring Semester EIE

APPLICATIONS MUST BE TURNED IN TO THE BOOKKEEPER PRIOR TO THE DEADLINE. IF YOU SUBMIT ONLINE, YOU MUST BRING IN A PRINTED COPY.

If you are requesting scholarships for more than one child in your family, you must submit a separate application for each child and for each event or function for which you are applying.

CRITERIA

- 1. An applicant for scholarship assistance must maintain good standing in Congregation Albert*. Applicants will be determined as eligible for recommendation based on the following rules of participation:
- a) All religious school applicants must commit to attend at least 80% of classes each semester.
- b) All applicants for NFTY events will be determined on a merit basis and 50% participation in Temple Youth Groups (TYG) at the time of the scholarship deadline. Events are subject to approval by Temple Youth group Coordinator and Director of Lifelong Learning.
- c) All applicants for camp scholarships will be determined either by active enrollment in religious school, active involvement in TYG, or the family's continued involvement in Congregation activities.
- d) All applicants for EIE High School in Israel will be determined by either active enrollment in religious school or active involvement in TYG.
- e) Jewish youth programs must be under the umbrella of the Reform movement and a program in which CA formally participates in order for the applicant to be eligible to receive scholarship funds.
- 2. Once the applicants' participation has been verified and recommended by the Director of Jewish Education or Temple Youth Group Coordinator, the application will proceed to the Scholarship Committee.

Applications submitted after the deadline will not be considered.

3. The parent or guardian will be contacted by the Scholarship Committee if the responses on the application are incomplete or ambiguous. The Committee may decide to return the application for corrections, completions, and or/clarity. Unfortunately this action might delay processing and could result in missed deadlines.

^{*} A member whose payment of dues or other assessments is in arrears for six months or more and who has not made other arrangements with the Congregation for payment of his or her obligations is no longer entitled to the rights and privileges of a member in good standing.
